COACHES & COMPETITORS Important Message

- All times are tentative, we will move up or back races or runs depending on race variables such as timing, weather, course conditions and other factors. All racers and coaches are responsible for keeping updated on course inspection and race times. Any changes will be announced to coaches, over the PA system and posted on scoreboards.
- Tyrol will open the “B” Chair early for inspection. Skiers and Boarders are not allowed to run on any other runs (Bumpbuster - skiers & Twister - Snowboarders) until 10:00 as the hill will not be open.
- Race format will be a 1 run GS race, a 1 run GS race, a 1 run BX race & a 1 run BX race

Preliminary Rundown:

Please note changes to schedule may occur as time, weather, logistics dictate

8:00am: Course Set Up GS on Twister - all set up volunteers should be at the base of chair B no later than 7:45

9:00am: Inspection of GS course on Twister

9:25am: Opening Ceremonies & National Anthem

9:30am: 1 run GS Race on Twister

10:30am (or immediately after run 1): run 2 of GS

11:30am: Course set for BX (probably on Sutter’s Ridge)

12:30: Course inspection

12:45: Speed Run

1:00pm: Race 1 for BX

2:00 (immediately following race 1): BX race 2

Immediately Following BX race 2: tabulation of championship & season results by officials

4:00pm: Championship Awards Presentation & Celebration in Tyrol Basin Chalet or outdoors if the weather is nice.
